## ***Fact Sheet***

### **Florida Discount Drug Card Program**

Enrollment is easy.

#### **You may qualify if you are —**

Age 60 or older, without prescription drug coverage, or in the Medicare Prescription Drug Coverage gap.

OR Under age 60, without prescription drug coverage, and with an annual family income of less than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level. Qualifying incomes include those below the following:

\$32,490 per year (for an individual) \$43,710 per year (for a family of two) \$66,150 per year (for a family of four) Please ask about income limits for larger families.

#### **The Florida Discount Drug Card can —**

Savings will vary depending on the quantity, type and brand of the drug purchased. Average savings on 10 commonly used prescription drugs ranged from 5 to 42 percent. Be used at all participating pharmacies.

**What is the Florida Discount Drug Card Program?**

The Florida Discount Drug Card Program is designed to lower the cost of prescriptions for Florida residents who have no drug insurance coverage. You may qualify if you are age 60 and older or if you are under age 60 with a total family income under 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Level. Qualifying incomes are \$2,708 per month for an individual, \$3,643 for a family of two, and \$5,513 for a family of four. **How do I apply for the Florida Discount Drug Card Program?**

Individuals and families who believe they are eligible for the Florida Discount Drug Card may enroll conveniently online or by telephone at 1-866-341-8894 (TTY Users may call 1-866-763-9630). Applicants affirm that the information provided on the application is true, complete, and accurate; no additional documentation of income, age, or residency is required. Within five business days of receipt of the application, the applicant's Florida Discount Drug Card will be mailed.

**Is there is an enrollment or application fee?**

No, there is no enrollment or application fee to join the Florida Discount Drug Card program. There is a one time \$1.50 activation fee per membership card that will be added onto the cost of the first prescription only.

**How much can I expect to save with the Florida Discount Drug Card?**

**Is there a discount on every drug?**

The Florida Discount Drug Card offers discounts on virtually every brand and generic prescription drug. The size of the discount varies depending on many factors.

**Are there discounts on diabetic supplies?**

Yes, the Florida Discount Drug Card provides discounts on diabetic supplies such as test strips, syringes and glucose monitors; however, a prescription from your doctor is required.

**Where can I use my Florida Discount Drug Card?**

Your Florida Discount Drug Card can be used at all participating Florida pharmacies. There is also a mail order option available. To find a participating pharmacy in your city, county or zip code area, please search our Pharmacy Locator or call the participant help desk at 1-866-341-8894 (TTY Users may call 1-866-763-9630).

**What do I do if my pharmacy will not accept the Florida Discount Drug Card?**

All participating pharmacies will accept the Florida Discount Drug Card. If your pharmacy is not enrolled as a participating pharmacy, you can encourage them to enroll in the program. The pharmacy can enroll in the program by calling our 24-hour pharmacy help desk at 1-800-361-4542. The help desk staff will enroll the pharmacy on a temporary basis so that you can fill your prescription immediately. The help desk will also send the pharmacy a contract to permanently join the program.

**Can the Florida Discount Drug Card be used with other discount cards?**

You can have other prescription discount cards along with the Florida Discount Drug Card. However, you can only utilize one discount card at the time of purchase.

**Can individuals on Medicaid use the Florida Discount Drug Card?**

No, because Florida's Medicaid program provides comprehensive coverage of prescription and some over-the-counter medications. While certain Medicaid consumers may be subject to a small co-pay for specified drugs, in most cases the total cost of the prescription is covered by Medicaid and at no cost to the consumer. However, if you are in the process of spending down your assets – meaning you are using your own money to pay for medical costs until Medicaid coverage begin – the Florida Discount Drug Card can be used until you become eligible for the Medicaid benefit.

**How do I receive my medications?**

Present your Florida Discount Drug Card when purchasing prescription drugs at any participating pharmacy. Participants can also choose a mail order option that provides a 90-day supply mailed to their home or office.

**Will I ever pay more using the card than I would without the card?**

No. Cardholders will always pay the lower of the price listed on the Florida Discount Drug Card website or the usual retail price at the pharmacy.
